Abstract

This paper presents an otherview of the different ways Csound¹ is integrated in the Surmulot² system for computer-assisted music composition. Surmulot bipolar structure is clearly exposed to the user: while Emacs provides a full-fledged textual IDE for Csound, Squeak calls Csound mostly silently in the background for a number of tasks, from sound files mixing to musical phrase synthesizing. Csound scores can also be built explicitly in μ O by using specific musical elements.
